

Go on a High Tech Treasure Hunt!

Experience the thrill of “the find” on this exciting treasure hunting activity. The focus of this activity is on communication, group cooperation and problem solving skills. Participants learn to operate GPS (Global Positioning System) units to hunt for hidden treasures called caches, that are stashed in natural or urban hiding spots.



Geocaching

This fun and exciting group activity is perfect for a variety of group sizes. Participants meet at a predetermined starting point where knowledgeable facilitators begin the day by reviewing the days agenda, teambuilding goals, and rules of the game. Teams will receive all the necessary equipment to meet challenges, including interactive clues to locate each challenge station and a GPS device. The group will be broken into teams. During the day, teams may visit historic sites, beautiful vistas, and the local hot spots as they travel, search and locate each cache.

This high-energy, team building activity fosters innovative thinking, shared leadership, and time management in a blend of competition and collaboration. Along the journey, groups will also learn about the geography and natural history of the city of Santa Barbara.

Teams will be competing for the fastest overall time to complete and locate all the cache finds in the course. In order to succeed, participants will need to think strategically, build trust, and manage limited resources intelligently. Facilitators debrief with all the teams afterwards to relate their experience to work, school and life.
