

Team Building in Santa Barbara's Front Country

This Orienteering program consists of a series of group initiatives focusing on the development of communication methods, prioritizing, and problem solving techniques. Through active experimentation, reflection, and application of skills, participants explore the complex and transformative meanings of trust, cooperation, and abstract thinking, all of which culminate into a unique bonding experience.



Get Lost Orienteering

Participants meet at the trailhead in the Montecito foothills, where friendly and knowledgeable facilitators welcome everyone and give preliminary instructions for the course. Teams will be chosen and given a map, compass, and a clue to their first challenge station.

Once on the trail, each team must complete their team challenge before they orient themselves to the next station along the 3 mile trail. The trail loops around beautiful chaparral, streams, and waterfalls, with amazing views of peaks and the shoreline of Santa Barbara.

While working together to navigate through the trail and completing team building challenges, participants will experience the natural beauty of the Santa Barbara outdoors. Throughout this exciting program, skilled facilitators guide discussions that directly address parallels to work, school, and life. Adventure-based learning is a great way to stretch oneself emotionally, physically and mentally.
