

## Explore One of the World's Largest Sea Caves!

Come explore Painted Cave, one of the longest and largest Sea Caves in the world! This amazing day of adventure departs from Santa Barbara Harbor and includes world-class sea kayaking, hot food and a comfortable charter boat complete with hot showers and bunks. The scenery, wildlife and vistas make this one of the most exciting trips California has to offer!



### Sea Cave Kayak @ Painted Cave, Santa Cruz Island

The charter boat leaves from Santa Barbara Harbor in the morning as guests enjoy a continental breakfast complete with hot coffee and pastries. Watch for migrating whales and dolphins as the charter boat cruises cross the channel to Santa Cruz Island.

Once the captain drops anchor, friendly and knowledgeable guides will outfit guests with their equipment for the day including wetsuits and helmets. Instructors will give a comprehensive paddle demonstration and safety orientation to make sure guests are comfortable and ready.

During the 2-3 hour paddle guests will explore the coves and caves of the island, including Painted Cave. This enormous cave is nearly a quarter-mile long and 100 feet wide, with an entrance ceiling of 160 feet. Guides will discuss the natural history and geology of the island, and point out interesting marine life. Often we see nesting sea birds, varieties of pinnipeds, sea lions and harbor seals, as well as other endemic wildlife.

After kayaking guests may have time to enjoy some snorkeling. There is an abundance of sea life in the Channel Islands Marine Sanctuary. Once on the boat, guests can take a hot shower before enjoying a hot meal on the way back to the harbor.
