The redwood groves and rocky peaks of this coastal mountain range are an ideal backdrop for a hands-on, dynamic approach to teaching students about backcountry leadership, teambuilding and wilderness skills.



Explore Big Sur's Coast and Redwood Forest!

Day one begins when the group meets our friendly and knowledgeable guides at the campground. The group will be taught camping and wilderness skills and most of the camping equipment is provided. Teambuilding exercises help students bond and work together to enjoy, survive and excel in the great outdoors!

Once settled into camp, students explore the nearby beaches and mountains, learning about natural history and marine ecology. The second day students embark on an overnight guided backpacking expedition in the back country. Their wilderness skills will be tested and practiced. The 10 mile round trip will leave the students feeling like they accomplished a true feat!
